LIKELY MINISTER OF PUBLIC HEALTH. Typoid outbreak in Ottawa brings question home to the Government—Temporary Department also suggested.

LIKELY MINISTER OF PUBLIC HEALTH. Ottawa, Aug. 2.—The creation of a Dominion department of public health which from time to time has been suggested, has received an impetus from the renewed typhoid outbreak in Ottawa and the obvious incapacity of the civic authorities to cope with the situation.

LIKELY MINISTER OF PUBLIC HEALTH. The matter was brought to the attention of the government some months ago, the idea being that there should be a deputy minister, if not a full-fledged minister of public health with a corps of medical men in charge. Mature consideration was promised. The fact that the government has upwards of five thousand employees in its service in Ottawa, the health of whom is essential to proper administration, has brought home the desirability of something as a matter of self-protection, if for no other reason. The suggestion has been made that a temporary department of public health be established under the Hon. Dr. Roche, secretary of state, who though for years in politics, has always kept up active practice as a physician of the first class.
