An Act to incorporate the Society called "l'Union St. Henri des Tanneries des Rollands."

HEREAS an Association under the name of "L'Union St Henr Preamble des Tanneries des Rollands, has existed several years in the City of Montreal, having for its object the aid of its members in case of sickness and the ensuring of like assistance, and other advantages to the widows and children of deceased members, And whereas the most soft the said Association have played to be incorporated, and it is expedient to grant their petition, Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows

40 appertaining to the said Corporation, and to the government and management thereof, in so far as the same may come under their control, respect being nevertheless had to the regulations, stipulations, provisions and by-laws to be hereafter passed and established.
