

HODGINS, WILLIAM T. (*Carleton, Ont.*)

Grands. of William Hodgins, a native of Tipperary Irel., who was one of the earliest settlers in the Co. of Carleton, Ont. S. of the late John Hodgins of Tp. of Goulburn. B. 27 Feb. 1857, and ed. at the Common School there. A farmer.—Was a mem. of the Municipal Council of Tp. of Goulburn, 1888. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Hazeldean, P.O.*

HUTCHINS, WILLIAM HENRY. (*North Middlesex.*)

Father was a native of Irel. B. in the Co. of Stormont, Ont. Ed. at the Public School, Tp. of Osnabruck. M., Miss Armitage. Is a grain and produce merchant. Was Reeve of Lucan for two years, and the first Mayor of Parkhill. First returned to Parlt. at last g. e. A Conservative and favours reciprocal trade in natural products with the United States.—*Parkhill, Ont.*

HYMAN, CHARLES SMITH. (*London.*)

S. of Ellis W. Hyman who came to Canada from Pennsylvania in 1836. Mother, a dau. of the late William Niles who represented Middlesex in the Leg. Assem. of Canada in 1854. B. at London, Ont., 1854. Ed. at Hellmuth Coll., London. M., 1876, Elizabeth, dau. of John Birrell of London. Is a tanner. Was Alderman and Chairman of Finance Com. of London, 1882-83; Mayor in 1884 and Presdt. of Board of Trade, 1881-82. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e. A Liberal.—*London; Rideau Club.*

INGRAM, ANDREW B. (*East Elgin.*)

Grandfather was a native of Tyrone, Irel., and, after nineteen years' service in the British Army under the Duke of Wellington, came to Can. and died in the Co. of Halton, Ont., 1854. Second s. of the late Thomas Ingram, a native of Quebec. B., 23 April, 1851, at Strabane, Co. of Wentworth. Ed. at Morristown and Aberfoyle, Ont. M. at St. Thomas, 1 June, 1882, Elizabeth, dau. of Allen McIntyre, of Aberfoyle. Is a railway employee, and is Presdt. of the St. Thomas Trades and Labour Council. Occupied position of trust under the Clarke Administration in Manitoba, in 1874. Represented West Elgin in Leg. Assem., Ont., from 1886 to 1890. First returned to Commons at last g.e. A Liberal Conservative.—*St. Thomas.*
