A merchant. First returned to Parlt. for present seat at last g.e. A Conservative.—*New Glasgow.*

CAMPBELL, *Lieut.-Col. Hon. CHARLES JAMES, J.P.* [*Victoria.*]

Descended from the Campbells of Barcaldea of Lochew. Fifth s. of the late Capt. John Campbell of Duntulm, by Isabella, dau. of the Rev. John McRea, minister of Kintaile, Ross-shire. B. in Sky, Inverness-shire, Scot., 6 Nov. 1819. Came to N.S., 1830. M., Jan., 1843, Elizabeth Jane, sec. dau. of the late Styles Ingraham, Esq. of Baddeck. A merchant, and prop. of the New Campbell Coal Mines. Apptd. a Coroner for Cape Breton, 1847, and a J.P. for same county.
