Ex-officio members of the Corporation may as. socinte certain persons with themselves as nembers.

Exclusive application of funds to educational purposes.

Comimon Schools may be placed in connection with the Aca. demy.
Meetings of the Corporation ; election of President, de.
II. The said Corporation shall also have power at any time to associate as Members thereof, the two chief Masters in the said Academy, with three other persons resident in the locality, or so many of the said masters or persons as the ex-officio members of the said Corporation, may think proper, so as to make the number of members of the Corporation not more than eleven, nor less than six ; and such masters and persons shall be chosen every two ycars, by the Curé and School Commissioners, who shall be the ex-officio members of the said Corporation: Vacancies among such non-official members may be filled by the Corporation from time to time.
III. Provided always, that all the revenues and income of the said Corporation shall be applied exclusively to the support of the said Academy and the furtherance of education therein, and to the construction, improvement or repairing of the building required for the purposes of the Corporation, in such manner as the members shall consider best adapted I to the said purposes.
IV. By the said name of the St. Césaire Academy, the said Corporation may sue and be sued in all Courts of Law or Equity in this Province; and for the purposes of any such suit, the service of process shall be made on the President of the said Corporation, and all suits by 20 the Corporation shall be conducted by him in its name.
V. The members of the said Corporation may, by their By-laws and Regulations, place the Common Schools of their School Municinality, in conncction with the said Academy, with a view to the furtherance of clementary education.
VI. The nembers of the said Corporation may meet from time to time for the transaction of business; and at every such meeting a quorium shall be competent for the transaction of any business; and the said members shall yearly, at the Annual Meeting to be held in the month of July, or at the next meeting thereafter, elect one of their number to be
the President of the said Corporation; and the Corporation shall bave power to appoint masters in the said Academy and such other officers and servants as may be necessary, and to fix their remuneration, and from time to time to remove any of them and appoint others in their stcad.

Annual Return to the Governor.
VII. The said Corporation shall make to the Governor, in the month of January, a Return shewing the real and property heid by it, under this Act, with a list of the members of the Curpuration, a copy of its By-laws and a Statement of the course of study followed in it.
