An Act to repeal the Act authorizing the establishment and maintenance of Separate or Sectarian Schools in Upper Canada.

WHEREAS the establishment of Sectarian or Separate Schools in that part of this Province called Upper Canada has been attended with evil effects in many parts thereof: And whereas the peace, welfare and good government of that part of this Province require that such Separate or Sectarian Schools should be wholly abrogated and abolished; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:—

1. From and after the twenty-fifth day of December, which will be in this present year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, the Act forming chapter sixty-five of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, and intituled, "An Act respecting Separate Schools," shall be, and the same is hereby repealed.
