Night flying washed in 1905 hours.</p> <p>At about 0200 hours, Hangar No. 1 caught fire and within a few minutes was burned to the ground.</p> <p>At 1000 hours, Squadron Leader J.D. Parks of Air Force Headquarters, arrived by air.</p> <p>At 1430 hours a brief funeral service was conducted by Flight Lieutenant Clark at the Jennett Funeral Home in Barrie for Pilot Officer J.A. Gore (AUS 422641) who was killed in a flying accident at this Station, November 28th.</p> <p>In the Station theatre at 1800 hours, Squadron Leader Parks spoke to all Officers and N.C.O.s. He indelibly impressed upon the minds of his listeners, the need for a high standard of morale; the danger of a letting up in our endeavors toward victory and the value of healthy minds and bodies.</p> <p>At 1945 hours a picture was shown in the Station Theatre.</p> <p>At 2030 hours a dance was held in the Airmen's Mess for N.C.O.s, airmen and airwomen with the station band in attendance. Following the dance, refreshments were served.</p>
