Uplands, Ontario	14th October 1943		Overcast, hazy. Amateur Night at the Recreation Hall with an outstanding programme of entertainment provided to an appreciative audience by strictly local talent. This is the first of a series which, it is hoped, will lead to a review equal to the brilliant record of "Uplands Review of 1943". R184702 LAC Spencer, A.J., during night flying, in Harvard 3814, ran off runway and taxied over a boundary cone. Category D-4. No injury.	
	15th October 1943		Ground fog at first, cloudy to overcast.	
	16th October 1943		Overcast, intermittent rain. Abbot and Costello in "Who Done It" provided fine entertainment to a capacity audience at the Saturday night movie.	
	17th October 1943		Cloudy to overcast, scattered showers. Roman Catholic and Protestant church services to larger than normal gatherings. Special efforts made to increase voluntary attendance proved successful at both services. A special showing in the Recreation Hall of the movie, "Salute to Three", proved a popular surprise to personnel on the Station.	
	18th October 1943		Low clouds. The Fifth Victory Loan Campaign was inaugurated today at Uplands, with Flight Lieutenant A.M. Kennedy, in charge of organization on the Station.	
	19th October 1943		Overcast. Flying washed out in morning. GBL795446 LAC Bion, P.W.D., during night flying at Carp aerodrome, undershot runway in Harvard 2665 and hit a stump resulting in aircraft ground-looping. No injury. Category of accident C-3. The No. 7 "M" Depot all W.D. Band and Precision Squad visited the Station and carried out a route march around the various sections and flights. Following supper, the precision squad put on their display and the band gave a very enjoyable programme in the Drill Hall.
