Dear Senator:

Thanks very much for sending me the
Halifax Herald with account of the Convention.

If anybody is finding fault with the
support the Herald is giving the Conservative Party, his

exceedingly valuable support. I only wish the same could be
said of the press here. The Mail and Empire's front page
has been very helpful to the Hepburn Government and the Hepburn

staff there is Liberal. There is intense resentment against
this news-featuring of the Conservative Party's political
opponents, and I don't think the paper itself can compare in
its success financially with the Halifax Herald.
