

The money for the Petricanish
Indians has been hitherto
entrusted to the Missionaries
at that place, for expenditure
in the interest of those
Indians; that for the Moisie
and Seven Islands has
been expended in the purchase
of Flour and Lard, which
articles were entrusted to
Mr. Halliday at Moisie for
the relief of distress among
those Indians.

With regard to the
Mungun Indians, the Hudson
Bay Company at that
post were authorized to
afford relief to the amount
of \$100.00 in the Spring
and \$100.00 in the Fall of
each year. The money for the
