
Ottawa, 3rd October, 1907.

Sir,-

The Department not having received a voucher for the bacon delivered by J.Y. Griffin & Co. for the Norway House Agency, the Rev. Mr. Semmens was asked for a report in the matter. He states in his reply that he left the voucher for the bacon with you on board the steamer "Redwing", and upon receipt of the Department's letter went to the steamer and found the voucher amongst some loose ~~papers~~ vouchers which were on board. The voucher has since been received from Mr. Semmens and a cheque has been issued in favor of the Contractors.

I wish, however, to draw your attention to the fact that you should exercise more care in future in regard to the transmission of vouchers to Headquarters. If you had not been careless in this matter the Contractors would have been paid for the bacon some months ago.
