Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 11th instant, and in reply I beg to say that the Department will pay the Indians of the Mud Lake Band \$50.00 a year rental for the parsonage while you remain as teacher on the reserve.

I have also to inform you that your salary will be raised to \$400.00 a year from the 1st instant. This, with the rental of the house, will place you on the same footing as Mr. Cork when he was in charge of this school.
