

With Cheque.


Ottawa, 8th February, 1911.

Sir,-

I beg to enclose official cheque No. 5623 for \$900.00, being the amount at credit of Interest Account of Samson's Band, and I have to inform you that an equal per capita distribution should be made to the members of the Band and a pay-list in duplicate returned accounting for same.

Since writing you on the 15th December last the balance due the Government at that time, viz:- \$5818.66, has been reduced to \$851.98, and it is expected will soon be wiped out altogether, when further payments can be made in accordance with the terms of the surrender.
