
Ottawa, 1st April 1915.

Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th ultimo and note that a number of Indians desire that the Department will purchase for them a small reserve north of the Canadian Pacific Railway property near Missanabic.

Enclosed herewith is a blue print plan showing a tract of land south of Missanabic on Dog Lake which the Department purchased in 1904, for the use of the Indians. I shall be obliged if you will inform me what objection, if any, there is to the Indians <sup>to whom you refer</sup> using this tract of land. I shall also be obliged if you can ascertain and inform me what use is being made of the said tract of land.
