LEAVE & DUTY RATION CARDS

Personnel Proceeding on Leave

Commanding Officers will no longer be required to issue Ration Cards to personnel proceeding on leave. These cards will in future be issued by the Ration Division Officers of the Wartime Prices and Trade Board to personnel who present themselves at the office of these Division Officers and produce to the Officer:-

(a) In the case of Officers, a brief statement in writing from their Commanding Officer that they are on leave and the period for which such leave is granted. This statement will be retained by the Ration Division Officer, when he has issued the Ration Card.

(b) In the case of Other Ranks, by production of their Leave Pass.

NOTE:-- There are Ration Division Officers of the Wartime Prices and Trade Board stationed at frequent intervals throughout the Dominion.
