

of the Government of Canada in answer to the representations which had been made on behalf of the allied Tribes recognized that the allied Tribes are entitled to obtain from His Majesty's Privy Council decision of the Indian land controversy and agreed that the Government would give authoritative sanction for doing so.

The Minister of Interior having on the floor of the House of Commons on behalf of the Government of Canada definitely agreed that the Government will facilitate securing from the Judicial Committee of His Majesty's Privy Council decision of the Indian land controversy, the principal matter now requiring to be discussed between the allied Tribes and the Government of Canada is the particular method by which the Government will facilitate securing such decision.
