Enclosed are Certificate of Registration No. 29262 and Certificate of Airworthiness No. 1007 for your Cessna T-50 aircraft, CF-Serial No. 1541. These certificates must be carried with the Journey and Aircraft Log Book on board the aircraft on all flights. DCL

As an aircraft owner, it is recommended that you obtain the Air Regulations (fee 50¢) and the Engineering and Inspection Manual (fee \$2.00) from the Queen's Printer, Ottawa. In this respect your attention is drawn to Division II, Part VIII of the Air Regulations and to Para 5.6, Chapter V, Part I and Part II, Chapter VI of the Engineering and Inspection Manual. These publications contain mandatory instructions and procedures for the airworthiness and safety of your aircraft.

Since this Department cannot undertake to republish manufacturers instructions or service bulletins, you are advised to supply the manufacturer with your address for receipt of such information.

In view of the foregoing, it is important that you notify this Department of any change of address, in order that delivery of Information Circulars, Notams and other amendments affecting safety in aircraft operations may be continued.
