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Facts of Quebec's Early History....

Sept. 15th, 1535,—Jacques Cartier
landed on the banks of the St. Charles.

1536,—Jacques Cartier returned to
France.

May 23rd, 1541,—Jacques Cartier with
three ships arrived at (Stadacona).

July 16th, 1542,—Roberval with three
ships reached Cape Rouge.

Sept. 1st, 1542,—Cartier Died.

June 23rd, 1603,—Pontgrave and
Champlain reached Stadacona (Quebec).

Sept. 3rd, 1608,—Champlain founded
Quebec.

Sept. 18th, 1608,—Pontgrave sailed
for France, leaving twenty-eight men to
hold Quebec.

December 27th 1610,—Champlain en-
gaged to be married to Helen Boule.
