

VANCOUVER CLUB CONSTITUTION

1. This Association shall be known as Name
"The Vancouver Club."

2. The real and personal property of the Club is vested in the Granville Club Company, Limited, in trust for the Club on the terms and conditions and subject to the stipulations set out and contained in a decree of the Supreme Court of British Columbia, dated the 5th day of November, 1907, and shall be held or transferred by the said Company in such manner as may be directed by the Committee of Management for the time being, with the authority of a resolution passed by a majority of three-fourths of the members present at a special meeting of the Club, called for the purpose.
