HOTEL DIEU (HOSPITAL).—Situated on Brock Street—(Branch of the Hotel Dieu, Montreal, directed by the Sisters of St. Joseph)—Sister Brady, superioress. Erected in 1845, and capable of accommodating about 25 patients. It has a government grant of \$800 per annum.

ORPHAN ASYLUM (R. C.)—In connection with the Hotel Dieu, and under the direction of the same community.

PROVIDENCE ORPHAN ASYLUM.—Situated on Montreal, corner of Ordnance Street. Established in 1861, and under the care of the Sisters of Charity. Sister Mary of the Blessed Sacrament, superioress.
