This Parish is partly situated in the Electoral Division of St. François Xavier West, and partly in St. François Xavier East. Was established in 1824, by Rev. M. François Boucher. The Rev. Sisters of Charity founded a Public School in 1850, which has continued since. Is the seat of the County Court for Marquette East. This place is also commonly called "Prairie du Cheval Blanc" (White Horse Plain). Has a Roman Catholic Church, several good schools, stores, hotels, and two Post offices, named respectively, the western, Pigeon Lake, and the eastern, St. François' Xavier. Mail semi-weekly. Distance from Winnipeg 25 miles.
