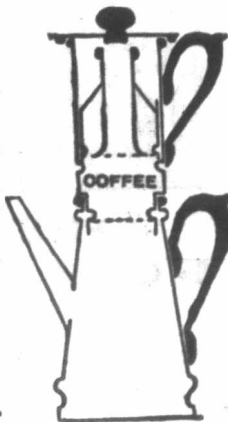

through the silvered wire

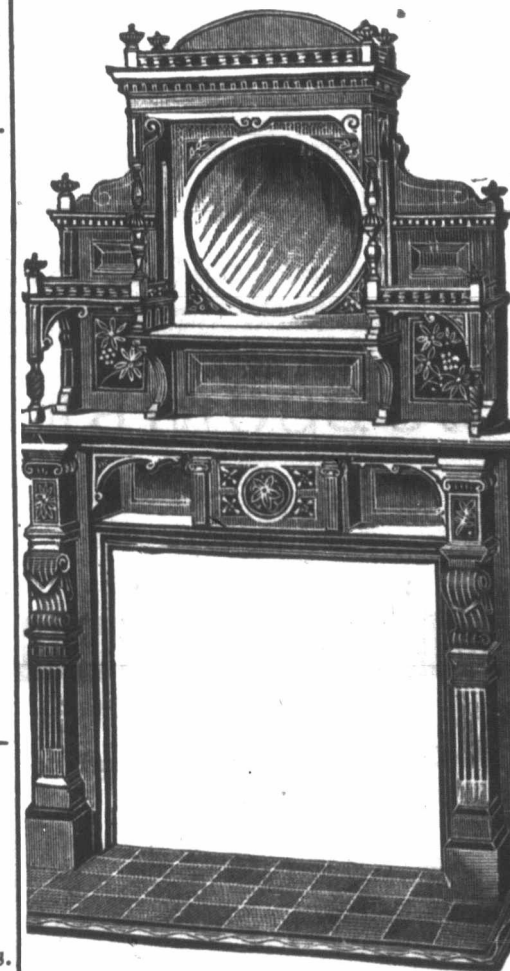
