"navigation," which A& was continued and amended by another A& passed in the forty eighth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "*An A& to continue for a limited time, an A& passed in the thirty sixth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, 'An A& for making a temporary provision for the Regulation of Trade between this Province and the United States of America, by land or inland navigation.'*" And Whereas it is expedient further to continue the said two A&s: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an A& passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "*An A& to repeal certain parts of an A& passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, 'An A& for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America,' and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province;*" And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the said A&, intituled, "*An A& for making a temporary provision for the Regulation of Trade between this Province and the United States of America, by land or by inland navigation,*" And also, the said A& intituled, "*An A& to continue for a limited time, an A& passed in the thirty sixth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, 'An A& for making a temporary provision for the Regulation of Trade between this Province and the United States of America by land or inland navigation,'*" and all matters and things in the said A&s contained, shall continue and be in force until the first day of January One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eleven, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the Provincial Parliament and no longer.
