AEt for making a temporary provision for the Regulation of Trade between this Pro-" vince and the United States of America by land or inland navigation," and all: matters and things in the faid Acts contained, shall continue and be in force until the first day of January One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eleven, and from thence : to the end of the then next Session of the Provincial Parliament and no longer.
