Make children's gingerbread with oat

A simple home remedy for croup is

alum and sugar. The way to use it is to

take a knife or a grater and shave off in

small particles about a teaspoonful of

alum; mix this with twice its amount of

sugar to make it palatable and administer

it quickly as possible. Almost instan-

taneous relief will follow.

Dr. Hammond warns people against

spending money for silk to be worn next

to the skin, principally for the reason

that it is not a good absorbent of mois-

ture. Wool is by all means the best.

JOHN WILEY'S—Two-thirds of a tea-

spoonful of soda, three table-spoonfuls of sugar,

one tea-spoonful of cream of tartar; one

egg one tea-spoonful of butter, six table-

spoonfuls of Indian meal, three table-

spoonfuls of flour and a little salt.

CREAM BUTTER.—Six eggs, separate

the yolks and whites, beat the yolks

with six ounces of powdered sugar and

the same of flour, whisk the whites and

then mix them together, add to it

whipped cream in proportion to the

sugar and flour, stir it carefully. Pour

the into moulds or paper cases and

bake.

CARROT PUDDING.—One pound of boiled

sweetened carrots, one pound of flour,

one half pound each of sugar, raisins and

currants, one quarter of a pound of cit-

ric acid, a little salt. Mix and tie in a

cloth and boil two hours or more. As

this receipt includes neither milk nor

eggs, which mixed it is as stiff as a loaf

of bread, and should be made in form to

boil.
