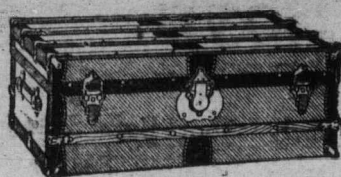

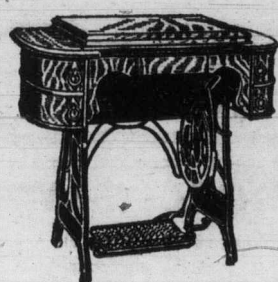

### Summary of Nighi Despatches

Paris, Aug. 23.—King Alexander, who has been operating on for appendicitis, was still bedridden and is not yet pronounced out of danger.  
Greece Force the Sakaria River.  
Smyrna, Aug. 23.—It is reported that the Greeks have forced a passage of the Sakaria River and are cutting the forces of Mustafa Kemal Pasha, the Turkish Nationalist leader, toward Angora, which they aim to occupy.  
Troubles in Nicaragua.  
San Juan del Sur, Nicaragua, Aug. 23.—The government has issued a decree of a state of siege throughout the republic. Disturbed conditions in the northern departments is given as the reason.  
Five Killed in Explosion.  
Mechanicville, N. Y., Aug. 23.—Five men killed and a sixth injured by explosion yesterday afternoon at a battery of three high pressure boilers of the West Virginia Pulp and Paper Company.  
Russian Workmen Weakened.  
London, Aug. 23.—Efforts of employed workmen in Russia to help famine sufferers are hindered by the fact that they themselves are weakened through lack of food, says a Moscow despatch to the London Daily Herald.  
The Church Intervenes in Ireland.  
Dublin, Aug. 23.—The hierarchy, as the Roman Catholic Church is known in Ireland, has intervened in the Irish peace negotiations. The Most Rev. Edward Mulhern, Lord Bishop of Down, came to Dublin last night with a message from the highest authority which he delivered to Mr. De Valera and over which long consultations were held. It is considered in best informed circles that Rome has intervened.  
Panama-Costa River Controversy.  
Panama, Aug. 23.—Panama is prepared and ready to repel the Costa Ricans should they invade the disputed Coto territory, but will take no action until it has been learned what attitude the United States government will adopt towards Panama in the event the Panamanians oppose the taking over of Coto by the Costa Ricans.  
Urges the 44 Hour Week.  
Winnipeg, Aug. 23.—At the Trades and Labor Congress here yesterday the convention called on the government to establish an eight hour day and a 44 hour week and urged the insertion of a fair wage clause in every contract involving the spending of public money.  
Insurance Rates in Dublin.  
Dublin, Aug. 23.—Insurance underwriters yesterday asked and were paid five times as much as was ordinarily paid to insure the plant of a Dublin newspaper in sympathy with Sinn Fein against riot or other civil commotion.
