



Mrs. Payne Whitney, who is regarded as the foremost horse racer in America. She is the daughter of the late John Hay, one-time United States secretary of state.



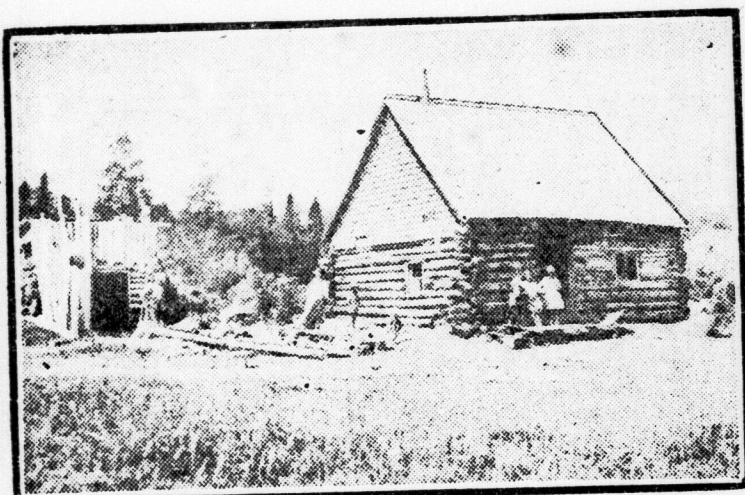

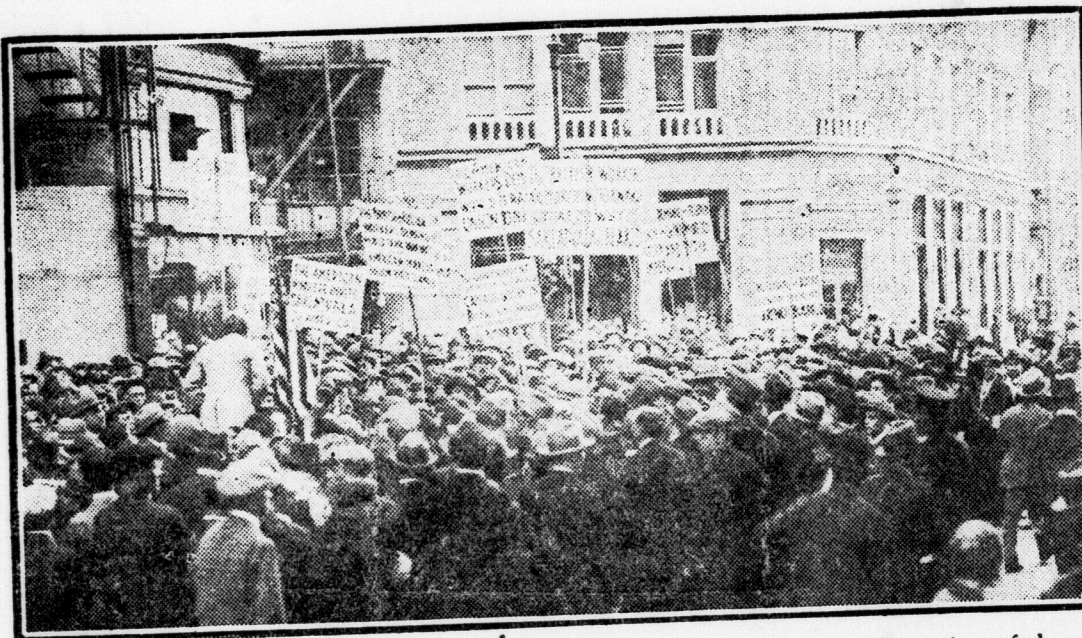

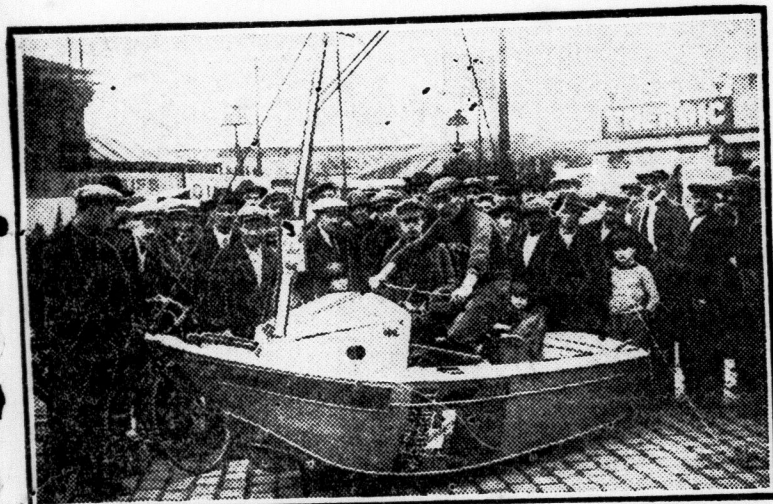
A pioneer's home located in the heart of a northern New Brunswick lumbering district.

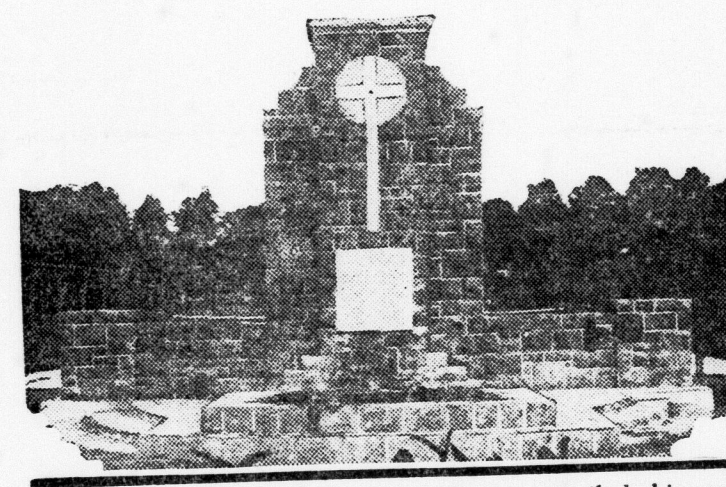

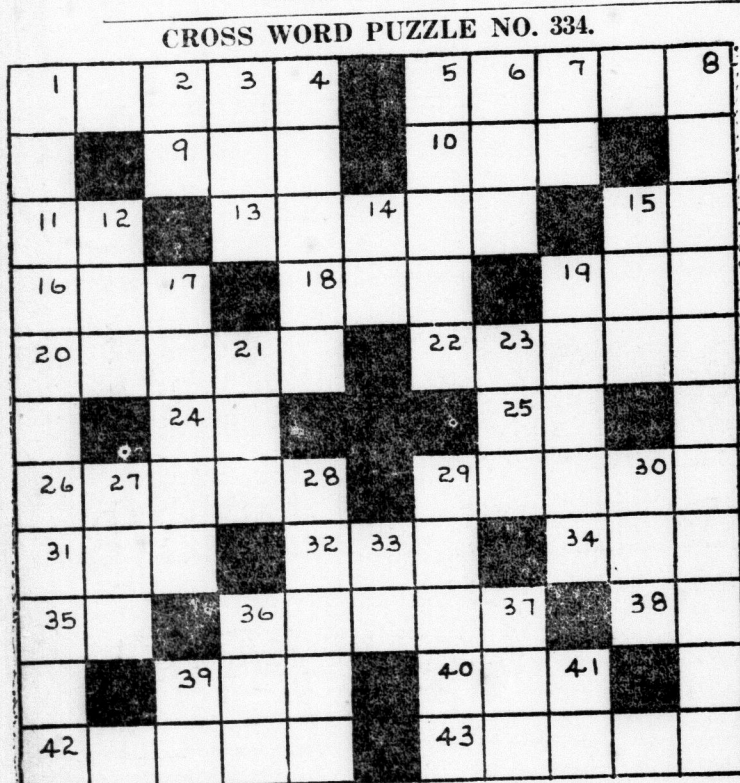
Marius Gallee of Paris, with the novel amphibian boat in which he travelled from Paris to Amsterdam, Holland. He built it around a bicycle.



Oyster fishing at Brightlingsea, Essex. Long rakes are used. The daily catch averages over 16,000.



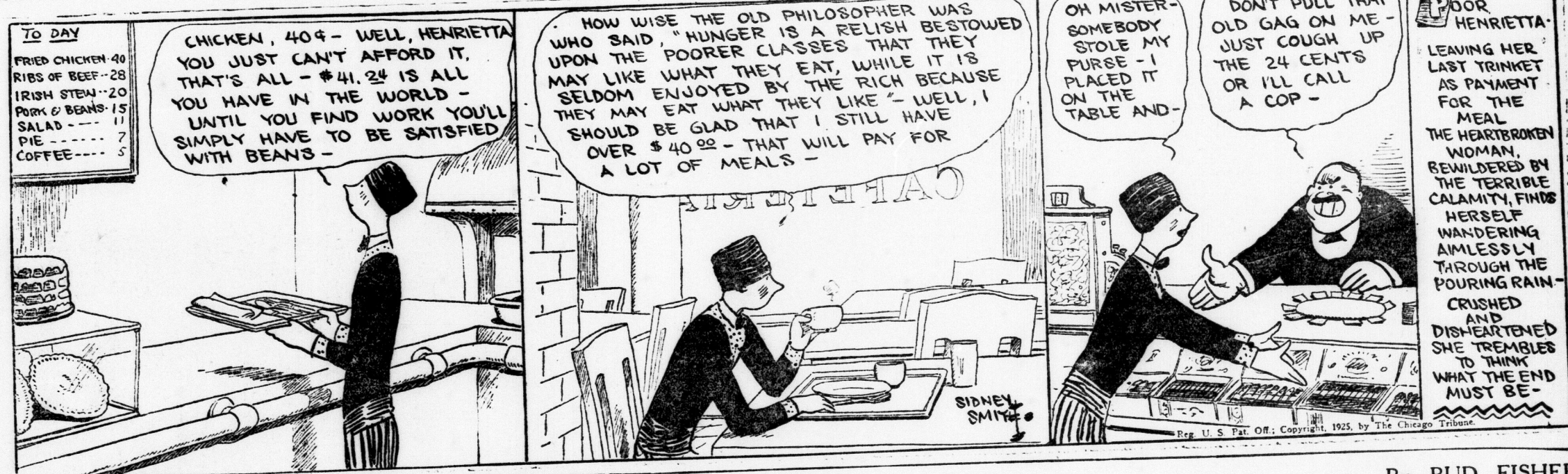
War memorial at Penetang, Ont., which was unveiled this week by Lieut.-Governor Cockshutt.
