MANITOBA, ON PARIO, AND THE DISPUTED TERRITORY.

Some people cannot understand why piece of territory which may be very valuable to Ontario can be comparatively worthless to Manitoba. But some people are very obtuse, and others belong to the class who are blind because they do not want to see. If Ontario gets the disputed territory she will have all the cost of administering it-no small item-but she will have to compensate her all the revenue derivable from the sale of lands, minerals, and timber. If Manitoba gets it she will have the cost of administration while the dominion government will gran the revenues. TRLEGRAPH POINTS.

There is a likelihood that Jay Gould has There is a likelihood that way to be lograph lost his grip on the Mutual Union telegraph company. If it is so competition will follew both in the United States and Canada. The Canada Mutual will begin the wo k of extension in the spring.

But there is no doubt that Gould has go the Great Northwestern of Canada, and under it the Montreal and the Dominion companies. The Western Union telegraph company, in the published statement o their assets, put down 2550 shares of Great Northwestern telegraph stock par value, \$255.000; marketable value, \$510,000. The charter of the company was purchased at \$25,000. and at this rate their nominal capital of \$500.000 is now worth \$1,000,000, not a bad thing for the Western Union company to make inside of one year out of this ransaction. The stock that the Western Union took over at \$25,000, represented in actual money paid in about \$5,000.

Bus when the deal was under consideration, and even after it had been made. 4200 of the 5000 shares of the Northwestern was held in Canada beyond the reach of Gould. We said at the time that this was a blind ; the indisputable facts are that our two Canadian companies were gobbled by Gould by means of Wiman and the Great Northwestern skeleton, and they are worked from New York.

THE DISPUTED TERRITORY.

The Progress and Mining Journal published at Rat Portage in the territory dis puted between Manitoba and Optaria repudiates certain statements made by a cor respondent in The World some days ago. This paper says one hundred million feet of timber will be taken out this winter en .ploying between 500 and 700 men. Laborers get \$2 50, carpenters \$3, plasterers \$5 per day, and girls \$12 a month, and cooks \$30. But, says he, the people there do not want to be a part of Ontario; Manitoba can appreciate the disputed territory with its inexhaustible supply of wood, its immense water powers and its minerals.
