ELECTRIC "RADIALS"

At the mention of electric 'radals," hydro or otherwise, many trains of thought are set in motion. They are "in the air" just now in more than one sense,—they are at present as castles in the air, and they are also the uppermost and predominant thought in what might be called the communal mind. They are, we are convinced, a very desirable thing to have in possession. Why? What makes them so desirable a possession that at the present moment the whole province is aroused, as were the children in Ruskin's story by a desire to possess themselves of brass-headed nails? It depends on the viewpoint. Some of these view points are wholesome and legitimate and some are hardly so commendable. There is a subtilty in the word "radial," as used instead of "railway line." The parts of the country that are really most in need of electric line." railway lines, are the rural districts. We say this with the full knowledge that much freight from the factories of our urban centres would be carried on these lines. The towns and cities have their steam railways, and their citizens and freight can go and come with a fair degree of facility and despatch. But there are many farms in our province which are from ten to fifteen miles from a railway station or a steam railway. It is the pass-engers and freight of these farms that need most consideration. We need electric railway lines. Why 'radials"? What is the word "radial" derived from? The word radius. What is a radius? The radius of a circle is a line running from the centre of the circumference; in a general sense, a line running out from a center. There we have it. An electric "radial" is an electric line running out from a centre. It is all very apparent then that this mild mania that has seized us at present really started with town and village and city boomsters who want corn brought to their own particular mill. Every city, town, village and country postoffice corner aspires to be the hub of "radials." "Radials" are the thing, not so much electric railway lines as "radials." But there is one thing certain these aspirants cannot all be centres. In fact but very few can be centres. So for the most of our citizens in the province these electric railways must be just electric railway lines and not "radials." "Radials" means a lot of wire-pulling and lobbying and unseemly rivalry. Electric railway lines placed in the proper places mean the filling of a great want. We need these electric railway lines. We need them primarily for our farming communities and secondarily for the freight

FRANK TERRACE, ADDRESSING THE MR. FRANK TERRACE, To Good Roads Convention at Tacoma, Washington, gave the following enthusiastic testimony in favor of good roads:

"I am a cabbage grower. I haul my produce to the sauerkraut factory at South Seattle. Before the road over which I travel was built, I had to get up at 4 o'clock in the morning to start on my The limit of the load I could haul with a team of 1800 pound horses was 2500 pounds, and after visiting the factory I would arrive back at my home late in the evening. But look at the difference now that a permanent hard surface has been laid down. I start on my trip about 8 o'clock and need only a team weighing 1400 pounds to haul a load of 5000 pounds of cabbage, which is double my previous capacity. And, best of all, I find on my return to the house early in the afternoon, that I have finished the day's work without the horses having turned a hair."
