6. The negative of the verb, in addition to kah or kahween (not) prefixed, require the introduction of a second particle se, besides, in some of the inflections, a chang in the ending of the verb.

7. A doubtful sense may be given to one's words by the use of the dubitative for

of the verb.

8. The only other peculiarity that we will mention here, is the use of the particle bun, which, whether with nouns, adjectives, or verbs, has generally the signification gone by, past, deceased, out of date, &c.
