grammes to provide funding assistance to individuals and groups to help with activities falling under various aspects of our mandate. Scholarship was promoted through the selection, by an outside jury of scholars, of persons pursuing studies at a number of universities who were given awards. In addition, three Canadians were given assistance to cover the costs of attending a two-week seminar on North American and European relations in Austria. Details of award holders and other relevant information may be found in Annex G.

Guided by the recommendations of panels of outside advisers, grants and contributions were made to a number of non-governmental

organizations, academics and individual researchers to assist with a range of projects in the fields of peace and security. These endeavours all fell within those parts of our mandate calling for the fostering and funding of research and the encouragement of public discussion. Annexes I and J provide details.

Finally, our modest programme of bursaries to help with other activities that might not be eligible under our more major programmes, continued. Recipients are shown in Annex F.
