Environment Cooperation Arrangement Signed with Sao Paulo

From February 8 - 20, 1989, the Right Honourable Jeanne Sauvé, Governor General of Canada, made state visits to Uruguay and Brazil. An Arrangement on Environmental Cooperation was signed with the State of Sao Paulo to facilitate technical cooperation between Canada and Brazil on environmental questions. This arrangement

will provide a framework for collaboration between the two parties in areas such as water and air pollution, toxic chemicals, and training and research methodologies. Mme. Sauvé's discussions centred on the serious challenges facing South America and Canada's role in the continent's political, economic and social development.
