Major Development Projects Financed by Canada:

Bilateral aid disbursements between 1965 and 1981 have amounted to \$182.4 million. 46 bilateral projects are operational with total approved budgets of \$270 million; a further 9 projects valued at \$260 million are in the planning stage. Noteworthy among approved projects are the Banda Aceh/Meulaboh Highway (\$47 million), Lombok Island High Level Diversion irrigation project (\$13 million), the Bukit Asam Coal Transport project (\$185 million), and the Suralaya Power Plant in Java.
