DECLARATIONS MADE BY CANADA
PERTAINING TO ITS ACCESSION TO
THE UNITED NATIONS CONVENTION ON
CONTRACTS FOR THE INTERNATIONAL
SALE OF GOODS, CONCLUDED AT
VIENNA ON APRIL 11, 1980

The Government of Canada declares, in accordance with Article 93 of the Convention, that in addition to Alberta, British Columbia, Manitoba, New Brunswick, Newfoundland, Nova Scotia, Ontario, Prince Edward Island and the Northwest Territories, the Convention shall extend to Quebec and Saskatchewan.

The Government of Canada declares that the declaration made at the time of its accession to the Convention, in accordance with Article 95 of the Convention, remains in effect.
