Statistical Report -- Interpretation/Explanation

During fiscal year 1997-98, the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade received 316 requests pursuant to the <u>Access to Information Act</u>. One hundred and five requests were carried over from the previous reporting year. Of these 421 requests, 323 were completed during the period under review and 98 were carried forward. One hundred and twenty-two requests were completed in 30 days or less and a further 58 were completed in less than 60 days. The remainder (143) required more than 60 days to complete.
