ANNEX B

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF BOLIVIA

- I. Unless otherwise indicated in subsidiary arrangements, the Government of Bolivia shall provide and defray the services and expenditures mentioned below.
 - 1. Furnished premises and office services in compliance with the standards of the Government of Bolivia, including adequate facilities and material, and telephone, mail and any other services which the Canadian personnel would need in order to carry out their duties;
 - 2. The granting of entry, exit and visitor's visas to Canadian personnel and their dependants;
 - 3. The recruiting and seconding of counterparts when required for the project,
 - 4. Any assistance for the purpose of facilitating the travel of Canadian personnel in the performance of their duties in Bolivia;
 - 5. Any assistance for the purpose of expediting the clearance through customs of equipment, products, materials and other goods required for the execution of projects and the personal and household effects of Canadian personnel and their dependants;
 - 6. The storage of articles mentioned in paragraph 5 above during the period when they are held at customs and any measures required to protect these articles against natural elements, theft, fire and other danger;
 - 7. The rapid dispatch, taking into account existing facilities of articles mentioned in paragraph 5 above from the customs location in Bolivia to project sites, including the obtaining of priority by Bolivian forwarding and transportation agents;
 - 8. Permission to use all means of communication such as frequency radio transmitters and receivers approved in Bolivia and telephone and telegraph networks, depending on the needs of programs and projects;
 - 9. Reports, records, maps, statistics and other information related to projects and likely to help Canadian personnel;
 - 10. Other measures within its jurisdiction in order to eliminate all obstacles hindering the execution of projects.
- II. The Government of Bolivia acknowledges that each Canadian staff member shall be entitled to a period of annual leave.
