UNESCO - CONFERENCE ON CULTURAL POLICIES

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Mark MacGuigan, announced today the composition of the Canadian delegation to the second world Conference on Cultural Policies (MONDIACULT) convened by UNESCO in Mexico City for the period July 26 to August 6.

The Honourable Gérard Pelletier, P.C.,
Ambassador and Permanent Representative to the United
Nations in New York, will head the Canadian delegation
which includes high level representatives from Quebec,
Ontario, New Brunswick and Alberta. The Quebec Minister
of Cultural Affairs, Mr. Clément Richard, will be a
ministerial delegate along with Mr. James J. Wah-Shee,
Minister of Aboriginal Rights and Constitutional
Development, Governement of The Northwest Territories.
Mr. John Bosley, M.P. for Don Valley West, Toronto, will
be parliamentary delegate.

Also serving on the delegation are representatives of the Canadian Conference of the Arts, the Canadian Commission for UNESCO, private cultural bodies and federal and provincial officials responsible for cultural affairs.
