Hon. Donald S. Macdonald (Minister of Energy, Mines and Resources) moved:

That Bill C-236 to provide a means to conserve the supplies of petroleum products within Canada during periods of national emergency caused by shortages or market disturbances affecting the national security and welfare and the economic stability of Canada, and to amend the National Energy Board Act, be amended by striking out subclauses (4), (5) and (6) on pages 26 and 27 thereof and substituting therefor the following:

"(4) A notice of motion to adopt an order made under subsection (3) shall be laid upon the table of each House of Parliament by or on behalf of the Minister for the Crown within seven days after the order is made or, if Parliament is not then sitting, within the first seven days next thereafter that Parliament is sitting.

(5) Subsections 11(3) (4) (8) (9) and (10) apply *mutatis mutandis* to an order made under subsection (3)"

Mr. Deputy Speaker: Is it the pleasure of the House to adopt the said motion?
