proper state of sanitation, with suitable ventilation and facilities for the prevention of the spread of disease. All buildings and equipment shall be subject to inspection. 2. Isolation quarters shall be provided for sick animals and for the housing of new additions of stock to the department. 3. New additions of stock shall be subject to inspection by a veterinarian at the time of purchase. A health certificate must accompany the animal upon arrival at the institution. 4. New additions of animals shall be kept in quarantine (at the college farm) until released by a veterinary certificate. 5. Accurate records should be kept concerning the health of all stock. Individuals used for experimental work of any description shall have a memo. concerning the nature of the experiment attached to their record. 6. Any suggestion affecting the management, the practices or the state of health of the stock held by the department shall be made in writing to the head of the department who is responsible for the burden.
