## IRIDACEÆ.

- Iris versicolor*  
 " *biflora*, Not Linn, n. sp.? Two flowered Iris. Leaves linear, shorter than the smooth round stem which is 8-10 inches high, and bears two light purple flowers, one of which withers before the other expands. Petals very small, linear-lanceolate. Flowers in June. Common at Cow Head, N.F.L. amongst short grass. Said by Prof. Babington to resemble *I. Virginica*.  
*Sisyrinchium Bermudianum?*

N.B.—I see no difference between this plant and the European *S. an'ceps*: I have never been able to gather a specimen in which the longer valve of the spathe did *not overtop* the flowers; although it is said *not* to do so in *S. Bermudianum*.
