land, and Ireland, on the Revolution found himfelf under the neceffity of leaving Britain, he fhewed a particular anxiety for the fafety of a little box he carried with him. Befng afked what its contents were, he faid, it contained the Lives and Fortunes of all the good People of England. Yet not a Shilling was fpent, not a Sword was drawn in fupport of his caufe.

Now, the cafe will be very different, indeed; and I fhall under-rate the gratuitous contribution, in fupport of their favourite Minister, of the City of LONDON, in estimating it at no more than Ten Millions. To LONDON, the great emporium, the great center and repository of the wealth of the World, Ten Millions will never be missed out of its great and boundless circulation; —a fingle ream of paper more than fupplies the want; —to the City of WFSTMINSTER I affign Five Millions; to WESTMINSTER, that City of Palaces, the Scat and Temple of refined Luxury, where Pleasure is pushed to the very confines
