REPORT OF SCHOOL AFFAIRS

Inspector Fotheringham Says That Overcrowding Will Soon Be a Serious Matter.

Toronto Junction, Dec. 18.—The management committee of the public school board met to-night, with Trustee Dalton in the chair. A report from Supervisor Wilson gave the attendance registered as follows:

Carlton 216
Western-avenue 287
St. Clair-avenue 160

Total 1229

The regular attendance during the past term has been 1229, or 58 per cent. Inspector Fotheringham's report was laid over. There has been an attendance of 257 more than last term, with 188 more enrolled. All the schools were well kept, excepting Carlton, where the rooms were dirty and heating very bad. He recommended that the hall walls be decorated with historical pictures and that Webster's unabridged dictionary be supplied to the senior third, junior fourth and senior fourth classes. He praised the teachers, the pupils generally reached high percentages. The penmanship report improved upon. Not enough time was taken to give the pupils an opportunity to become proficient. Overcrowding would have to receive serious consideration. Two new teachers would be needed after New Year's, one in St. Clair-avenue and one in Carlton School.

SIX CANADIANS IN THE RUNNING
FOR SEATS IN BRITISH PARLIAMENT

Two Are Up for Re-election—Something About the Personalities of the Other Aspirants.

(Canadian Associated Press Cable.) London, Dec. 18.—Among the candidates for parliamentary honors at the forthcoming general election are four Canadians. Hamar Greenwood, the Liberal candidate for York City, has for his opponent J. G. Butler, who was at the last election returned unopposed.

York City has two Conservative members, but there is a strong belief that Mr. Greenwood will be returned.

Foster Boulton, formerly of Toronto, is the Liberal candidate for North Huntingdon, and has for his opponent E. J. Davies, the late president of the board of agriculture. Mr. Davies' majority at the last election was 1,000, but it is thought that Mr. Boulton has a fighting chance.

H. E. Wyatt, well known in connection with the Navy League, is the Conservative candidate for Rushcliffe division. Nottingham, Wyatt's opponent is J. E. Ellis, who had a majority last election of 440.

Dr. Rankin Dawson, son of Sir William Dawson, Canada, is the Conservative candidate for East Edinburgh. Mr. Dawson, Liberal, the present member, had a majority of 1,200 at the last election.
