Jewish Father, 108

NEW YORK, April 2.—Leib
Litvin, 108 years old, will call
"father" to 1,000 Jewish way-
farers and immigrants tonight
in the conduct of a public
Seder, the first night's celebra-
tion of the Jewish Feast of the
Passover.

The Seder is the occasion of
home services, in which the
head of the family gathers his
household about him and reads
the story of the bondage of the
Jews in Egypt and their de-
liverance under the leadership
of Moses.

The public Seder was ar-
ranged by the Hebrew Shelter-
ing and Immigrant Aid Society.
The society also has arranged
a Seder for 100 Jewish immi-
grants detained at Ellis Island,
and has provided 1,000 pounds
of matzo for their use.
