I enclose herewith application of R.D. Affleck for a refund of \$8.50 paid on an interim mining lease Melva Fraction, on Upper Similkameen I.R.No.2, and forwarded to you on April 30, 1936.

It was found that this ground had been previously recorded in another mining district by the Hedley Amalgamated Gold Mines, Ltd. who established their precedence and eventually secured a lease covering the property and consequently no lease was ever issued in Mr. Affleck's favour.
