FREE RADIUM CLINIC FOR CANCER

Philadelphia General Hospital, Having Two Grams of Radium, Will Give Non-Paying Patients the Benefit.

Something new in municipal welfare work—the opening of a clinic in a city hospital for treatment of cancer sufferers by radium emanations—has been recently in Philadelphia. This is the first free radium clinic in the United States. The Department of Public Welfare, believing in the value of radium emanations to treat cancer, despite professional disagreements on the score, has purchased two grams of the precious substance. The clinic is an outgrowth of a pay radium clinic in Memorial Hospital, New York.

The radium for the Philadelphia hospital was purchased at \$77,000 a gram, a bargain price, as the ordinary value is \$100,000 a gram. Since there are altogether only 100 grams of radium salts, the city of Philadelphia is fortunate to obtain this amount. Ordinarily radium emanations are sold at \$13 a "millicurie," the standard of measurement for the radium emanation. The first test made at the Philadelphia General Hospital resulted in obtaining 250 millicuries, which would sell for \$3,250. When it is considered that the original investment was \$164,000 and that the emanations are given off for 1,000 years, the commercial value of the substance is easily recognized.

But the city proposes to charge only hospital costs, and should the patient be unable to pay even those few dollars a day, both treatment and hospital care will be furnished free. All cancer sufferers now at the hospital will be given treatment if their condition is such that it is believed radium will provide relief. From fifteen to twenty patients will be brought to the clinic daily from their homes, for treatment, and a special ward of sixty beds will be provided.

"It is our intention to proceed conservatively," said Dr. C. Lincoln Furber, director of the Department of Public Welfare. "We have no idea that radium is a cure-all. Some cases may require surgical treatment and others may be beyond the beneficial effects of radium. But we do know that a certain class of cancer cases are very greatly benefited by the radium treatment."

This substance, 150,000 times as valuable as gold, is kept in a lead-lined hermetically sealed safe in the hospital's pathological laboratory. It is in a room protected with a fine network of burglar

The chief sources of carnitine ore, from which radium is obtained in the United States, are in the Colorado and Utah. The ore is quite plentiful, but the radium content is lower than in pitchblende, the ore found in Bohemia, in which radium was discovered. The

ment is that it does not use up the radium itself. The gas or emanation increases in activity during the first few hours after it is drawn from the chamber in which it has accumulated. Then it dissipates. The tube containing the emanations can be used over and over during a period of three weeks. These tiny tubes glow in the dark with an indescribably beautiful greenish gold light, but the visible rays have no medicinal effect.

Radium, it is explained by the physicians in charge of the new clinic, does not be brought into intimate contact with the diseased tissues because of the radiation effect. Of course, the nearer it is brought to the cancer, the greater will be the effect. In handling this relatively large amount of emanation, safety measures have been adopted to protect the radium workers from the rays.

In the laboratory tubes are always handled with forceps. Applicators are prepared behind lead-lined boxes. Blocks specially designed to protect the most vulnerable parts of the body. The emanation apparatus is so constructed that the operator stands behind a lead plate at a considerable distance from the active part. Measuring instruments for a short time, but working range of the radio activity requires most careful safeguards against the powerful properties of this strange substance.
