


## ADVANCE OF DEMOCRACY

Prof. H. L. Stewart Delivered Powerful Address at Halifax Y. M. C. A.

(Halifax Chronicle.) That we live in a period of wild, crack-brained anarchy, an era of public meetings, an amazing surge and swell of talk, a half-manicured thirst to experiment—a condition of democracy which could only be cured by education on the fundamental principles of public affairs, more extensive, more intensive, more thorough, more persevering more widespread than any yet known—was Professor H. L. Stewart's declaration in the course of a brilliant address on education, delivered yesterday afternoon before the Y. M. C. A. as one of their Sunday afternoon series.


Professor H. L. Stewart dealt specially on what was described as the "Advance of Democracy." Democracy was not an order established for all time, but like a seed which grew in the soil, had in no country yet borne all the fruit with which it is charged. He took as his primary fact that the enveloping process was here, and involving possibilities for good or evil, whose magnitude no words could ever state. The cardinal interests of mankind were being swayed by the public opinion of masses. The date of the establishment of democracy in constitutional form was a matter for difference of opinion; there was no doubt that of it becoming a vital, dominating, force, "we have advanced."
