The present structure does not include the interior finishings nor the cost of heating. There is the further fact in connection with this type of building, that it will cost the Province \$100,000 less than would the steel structure; and the residents in the neighborhood will not be annoyed by the rattling of the steel riveters.

It is expected that when the office building is completed, with the wings which are to be added at some later date, it will house all the offices of the government, and will gather them from the various buildings in which they are now located and place them under the one roof. That will mean the centralization of the offices now on Richmond street, in Spadina Flouse, the Highways buildings on University avenue, and the Fire Marshal's department at Bay and King street. The plan of the building is in four sections, and the structure, which will be under way shortly, will take care of about two-thirds of the requirements.
