Lift line BLOCKADE

London, Nov. 28—The Times says that the absurd story which the Germans are reported to have spread semiofficially that the Entente probably will consider the abolition of the blockade, is absolutely unfounded. The Allies have not the slightest intention, the Times continues, of throwing aside their chief weapon for insuring the signature of a just peace and the performance of its constitutions, particularly in the present chaotic state of Germany.

After quoting evidence in an endeavor to refute Dr. Solf's declaration that Germany is starving, the newspaper says that German statements on this subject require careful examination. When the truth has been ascertained the Allies and the United States will allow the Germans from time to time during the peace negotiations such food supplies as humanity dictates, but the blockade must remain


