in that he

at Newmarket, Ontario, at 1030 hours, on the 2nd day of November, 1943, absented himself without leave from No. 23 Canadian Armoured Corps, (Basic) Training Centre, C.A., Newmarket, Ontario, until apprehended by the Military Authorities at Thessalon, Ontario, at 0800 hours, on the 5th day of February, 1944, dressed in civilian clothes. Cost of apprehension and return to his Unit being \$85.35.
