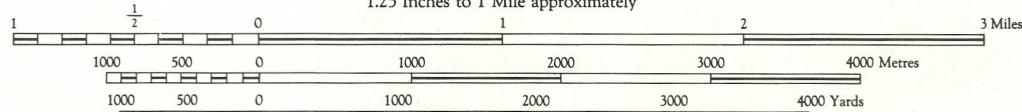

1.25 Inches to 1 Mile approximately



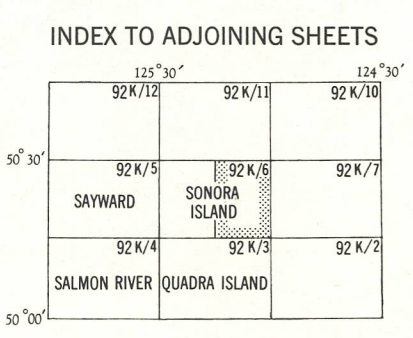
